Lawyering 2.0: contracting in the age of Al

Al is changing industries, job and role descriptions, and new use cases and opportunities for optimization, acceleration, augmentation and enablement are emerging rapidly. What does all of that mean for lawyering and how can we, as classically trained lawyers, think about how to adopt legal technologies and Al optimally for our use and acceleration? How do we prove our value as expert practitioners while relying on these emerging technologies and put emphasize on the right element of the value chain of legal services?

The answer might be in adoption of AI and generative AI as an assistive tool – to automate elements of the legal value chain that are more repeatable and rote, and aggregate value at the expert judgment layer of the value chain, enabling higher value work in less time. If we get it right, AI can effectively turn lawyers from drafters to phenomenal editors, who use AI for greater accuracy, enablement of expertise, creative strategy, and data accuracy.
